This update follows the Prime Minister's announcement of new national restrictions to combat the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic, effective from 5 November and expected to end on 2 December 2020.

The Prime Minister explicitly said that construction and manufacturing should continue to work and Hills Quarry Products sites will remain open for business.

All our workplaces and practices have been adapted to ensure they remain COVID-19 secure and we will continue to comply with Government guidance on managing the risks of COVID-19 including the five steps to safer working together. We have made arrangements for employees to work from home where their role permits.

The five steps to safer working together confirm that:

- We have carried out a COVID-19 risk assessment and shared the results with the people who work here
